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Press statement

The High School for Hearing Impaired Children Cluj-Napoca announces the official launch of the Junior HIPEN youth exchange project, RO-11-135-2009-R3- that will take place during the period 10.12.2009-15.07.2010, project finnanced by The European Union through The National Agency for Community Programmes in the Field of Education and Professional Forming as part of the programme Youth in Action, Action 1. 1- Youth Exchange.

The project's goal is the social inclusion of the hearing impaired youth and involves the active participation of 28 hearing impaired young people that come from four european countries: France, Great Britain, Slovakia and Romania. The budget of this project is 11,377 Euros.

Among the ojectives of the project are: the familiarization of the youth with other languages and cultures; gaining and consolidating communication abilities in other languages; the identification of the professional opportunities offered by the european job market for the hearing impaired persons; establishing connections and means of communication between the hearing impaired youth from Europe; the sensibilization and information of the public opinion regardind the hearing impairement; the identification of the need and opportunity to associate in a european level form.

Keeping in mind the basic need for social inclusion of the hearing impaired youth, the main themes of the activities are based on social inclusion and disability; promote the active citizenship of the youth, in general, and especially their european citizenship; develop solidarity and promote tolerance among young people, regarding the consolidation of the social cohesion in the European Union; encourage the mutual understanding between the youth from different countries and promote european cooperation in the youth field.

The youth exchange will take place in Cluj-Napoca and Bran in the period of 14. 06.2010 - 19.06.2010, and the activities are based on the use of non-formal learning methods such as: cultural workshops through which the youth know other cultures and civilizations; presentations of some socially integrated hearing impaired persons; debates over the theme of human rights; cultural and educational visits.

Our partners in this project are european institutions that offer educational, developmental, recovery and support services to the hearing impaired youth such as: Charlotte Blouin Center from France; Kremko - Civic Association from Slovakia and Exeter Royal Academy for Deaf Education from Great Britain.



Youth in Action programme

Action 1.1 Changes of young (between) people

Junior HIPEN Project

- it promotes the active citizenship of the young people, in general, and their European citizenship,in particular;
- O it develops the solidarity and promotes the tolerance between young people having in mind the consolidation of the social cohesion in the European Union
- O it sustains the peer trust between young people from different countries; it promotes the European cooperation in the field of youth.

The aim of the project:

The social integration of the young people with hearing deficiencies

The objectives of the project refer to:

- O Getting the young people familiar with languages and cultures
- Acquiring and developing of communicative abilities;
- O Identifying the professional opportunities from the European labour market which are appropriate for persons with hearing deficiencies
- O Establishing connections and communicative means between young people with hearing deficiencies from Europe;
- O Rising public awareness about hearing deficiencies
- O Identifying the need and the opportunity to create an European associations





The target group: 28 young people with hearing deficiencies

10 group leaders

- O Romania is participating with a group made of 8 young people (4 girls and 4 boys aged between 15 and 17) and 3 group leaders
- O **England** is participating with a group made of 6 young people (2 girls and 4 boys, aged between 15 and 20) and 2 group leaders
- France is participating with a group made of 8 young people(4 girls and 4 boys, aged between 15 and 17) and 3 group leaders
- O Slovakia is participating with a group made of 6 young people (3 girls and 3 boys, aged between 15 and 17) and 3 group leaders

The budget of the project: 11.377 Euro

- O Costs related to preparations
- O Costs related to the activity: accommodation, transport, food
- O Costs related to the dissemination

The young people exchange will take place during 14.06.2010-19.06.2010, and the activities are based on non-formal learning methods which involve:

- O Cultural workshops where the young people get to know other civilisations and cultures;
- O Introducing some socially integrated persons with hearing deficiencies;
- O Debates on human rights;
- O Cultural and educational visits
